## Minutes Meeting 1 of 2016 – ERACCC – 14 March 2016

#### 1 WELCOME & APOLOGIES

Dr King noted the apologies as listed above and welcomed members to the first meeting of 2016. Dr King advised the following:

- Paul Schollum is no longer working at WALGA and the Authority is awaiting confirmation of a replacement representative.
- Leon Bradley is stepping down as the ERACCC representative for the Pastoralists & Graziers
  Association. The Authority is waiting to hear of a replacement representative.

Dr King also advised that his term on the ERA's Governing Body will be concluding at the end of June 2016.

#### 2 MINUTES OF MEETING 4/2015 HELD ON 9 December 2015

The minutes were accepted as a true and correct record of the meeting.

#### 3 ERACCC MEMBERSHIP

Dr King advised that the Secretariat will shortly be contacting members to seek their confirmation that their organisation wishes to continue to be on the committee for the 2016-18 term.

#### **4 ERACCC STATUS REPORT**

Dr King invited Mr Paul Reid to speak to the LMCP sections of the Status Report. Mr Reid highlighted the following:

- Consultation period for the water licence review recently closed.
- The Authority has received the independent inspector's report on the Shire of Dumbleyung's non-potable water and sewerage infrastructure, and has decided to serve a notice of noncompliance on the Shire.
- The second round of consultation on the Code of Conduct for the Supply of Electricity to Small Use Customers closed on 26 February. The ECCC will prepare its final advice to the Authority.

Dr King spoke to the remainder of the Status Report, highlighting that both the Access Arrangements for the Dampier to Bunbury Natural Gas Pipeline and for ATCO Gas Australia's Mid-West and South-West Gas Distribution Systems are still under consideration.

Dr King further noted the Australian Competition Tribunal's recent decision to set aside the Australian Energy Regulator's price decisions in relation to four electricity network operators.

#### 5 MEMBER PRESENTATION - 2015 Cost of Living Report

Mr Chris Twomey, WACOSS, presented highlights from WACOSS's 2015 Cost of Living Report which has been produced annually since 2007. The 2015 report compares the adequacy of income against the costs of living in WA using three different low-income models: working family, single parent family and an unemployed single. The report found modest income increases for two of the three models.

Mr Twomey tabled a copy of the 2015 Cost of Living Report.

#### 6 ERA PRESENTATION – 2015 Water Performance Report

Mr Paul Reid, Assistant Director Monitoring, ERA, provided an overview of the performance of water service providers that are licensed by the ERA. Further information is set out in the 2015 Water Performance Report, which is available on the ERA's website.

#### 7 ERA PRESENTATION – 2015 Energy Retailers & Energy Distributors Performance Reports

# Minutes Meeting 1 of 2016 – ERACCC – 14 March 2016

Mr Paul Reid, Assistant Director Monitoring, ERA, detailed the key findings in the 2015 Performance Report for Energy Retailers, which included figures showing that competition in the natural gas market has intensified and gas disconnections were higher.

Ms Anu Besson, Senior Project Officer, ERA, provided an overview of the 2015 Energy Distributors Performance Report. The report showed that complaints to WA's electricity distributors are trending downwards.

Both the retailer and distributor performance reports are available on the ERA's website.

#### 8 ERA PRESENTATION - The Stolen Generation - Past & Present

Ms Christine Coyne, Christine Coyne and Associates provided a presentation on the past and present stolen generations, and described the lasting effects that the forced removal of Aboriginal children from their families has had on Aboriginal society. Ms Coyne highlighted the importance of including input from Aboriginal communities when designing programs to assist Aboriginal people instead of just relying on mainstream programs.

#### 9 ENERGY OMBUDSMAN'S REPORT

The report was taken as read. Mr Marcus Claridge, Director of Energy & Water, Energy and Water Ombudsman briefly highlighted that complaints are down for electricity, gas and water, and that this coincides with lower levels of complaints reported from other Energy Ombudsmen and the Ombudsmen of other industries.

#### 10 NOMINATION OF MEMBER TO PRESENT AT FUTURE MEETINGS

Dr King noted that there are currently no presentations listed on the agenda for the June ERACCC meeting and therefore encouraged members to consider nominating a presentation on behalf of their organisation. Dr King advised that the Secretariat would be in contact with members prior to the next meeting to seek possible presentation ideas.

#### 11 MEMBER'S ISSUES & QUESTIONS (Questions on notice)

There were no issues raised or questions on notice.
