# **A-Star Electricity Pty Ltd**

#### APPLICATION FOR AN ELECTRICITY RETAIL LICENCE

The Economic Regulation Authority is seeking public comment on an electricity retail licence application by A-Star Electricity Pty Ltd to sell electricity to contestable customers consuming in excess of 50 MWh per annum.

Under the *Electricity Industry Act 2004*, the Authority is responsible for licensing electricity supply services in Western Australia and must take all reasonable steps to decide on an application within 90 days of it being submitted.

The issuing of a licence is subject to the Authority being satisfied that it would not be contrary to the public interest to do so and being satisfied that the applicant:

- a) has, and is likely to retain; or
- b) will acquire within a reasonable time after the grant, and is then likely to retain,

the financial and technical resources to undertake the activities authorised, or to be authorised, by the licence.

The licence application can be found on the Authority's <u>website</u>.

The applicant has submitted a proposed standard form contract for the Authority's approval. The Authority will undertake public consultation on the contract separately.

Interested parties are invited to make submissions on the licence application by 4:00 pm (WST) on Friday, 17 January 2014.
