Western Power's Proposed Revisions to the Access Arrangement for the Western Power Network

ISSUES PAPER

The Economic Regulation Authority has published on its website an [issues paper](#) on Western Power's proposed revisions to its access arrangement for the Western Power Network.

The issues paper is intended to help inform interested parties about Western Power's proposed revisions, the review process and some of the key issues to be addressed by the Authority in making a determination on the revisions. It is not an exhaustive review of the content of the proposed access arrangement, or the matters that the Authority will address in making its determination.

While the Authority invites interested parties to make submissions on particular matters identified in the issues paper, submissions may be made on any element of the proposed revisions, or about the operation of the access arrangement more generally during the current access arrangement period.

A public forum will be held on Monday, 14 November 2011, about the proposed access arrangement revisions. A separate [notice](#) has been published on the Authority's website with further details.

Interested parties are invited to make submissions on Western Power's proposed access arrangement revisions by **4:00 pm (WST) on Monday, 5 December 2011**.
