APPROVAL OF REPLACEMENT ELECTRICITY STANDARD FORM CONTRACT

The Economic Regulation Authority has <u>approved</u> the replacement standard form contract for the supply of electricity to small use customers submitted by Rottnest Island Authority (**RIA**).

The Authority requested that RIA review its standard form contract to ensure compliance with the requirements of the new Australian Consumer Law and the current version of the *Code of Conduct for the Supply of Electricity to Small Use Customers.*

RIA completed its review and requested that the Authority approve the replacement standard form contract. In accordance with the Authority's <u>Public Consultation Guidelines for</u> <u>Electricity, Gas and Water Licences and Electricity & Gas Standard Form Contracts</u>, the Authority provided a 15 day public consultation period. There were no submissions received by the closing date of 24 November 2011.

Under the *Electricity Industry Act 2004*, the Authority must not approve a replacement standard form contract if it considers that the contract does not meet the relevant regulations, any other written law, or any term, condition or provision of the licence.
