### Retail Energy Market Company Rule Changes C06/11R, C01/12R and C02/12R

#### DECISION

The Economic Regulation Authority (**Authority**) has approved three amendments to the Retail Energy Market Company's (**REMCo**) Retail Market Scheme (**Scheme**).

The Authority is responsible for the economic regulation of the Western Australian Scheme, which includes the approval to amendments to this Scheme, under Part 2B of the *Energy Coordination Act 1994 (Act)*.

REMCo submitted three Rule Change proposals, i.e., C06/11R, C01/12R and C02/12R, to the Authority for approval, proposing amendments to the Retail Market Rules.

On 28 May 2012, the Authority approved these Rule Changes on the basis that they are classified as low impact and non-substantial under the Retail Market Rules, and are administrative and referential in nature. The Authority considers that the Scheme will continue to comply with the Act following the approval of these Rule Changes.

Rule Changes C06/11R, C01/12R and C02/12R are to take effect on 1 June 2012.
