Draft Decision on Western Power's Proposed Revisions to the Access Arrangement for the Western Power Network

PUBLIC SUBMISSIONS RECEIVED

The Economic Regulation Authority has published additional submissions from interested parties on the Authority's Draft Decision on Western Power's proposed revised Access Arrangement for the Western Power Network.

The submissions from the Shire of Ravensthorpe, Urban Development Institute of Australia and the Western Australian Major Energy Users, were received by the Authority after the intended closing deadline of 4pm (WST) on 29 May 2012.

The Authority has reviewed these late submissions and, on this occasion, has exercised its discretion under section 4.53 of the *Electricity Networks Access Code 2004 (Access Code)* to consider the content when preparing its final decision.

Under the Access Code, the Authority must publish its final decision on Western Power's proposed revisions within 30 business days after the due date for submissions, which was 29 May 2012.

Subject to any extensions of time or suspensions of deadlines, as permitted under the Access Code, the Authority's final decision is due to be released by 11 July 2012.

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
