## Retail Energy Market Company Rule Change C03/12R

### DECISION

The Economic Regulation Authority (**Authority**) has approved Rule Change C03/12R proposing amendment to the Retail Energy Market Company's (**REMCo**) Retail Market Scheme (**Scheme**).

The Authority is responsible for the economic regulation of the Western Australian Scheme, which includes the approval to amendments to this Scheme, under Part 2B of the *Energy Coordination Act 1994* (**Act**).

REMCo submitted Rule Change C03/12R to the Authority for approval, proposing to include a new Rule 14A in the Retail Market Rules that enables REMCo to grant an exemption for a Self Contracting User (**SCU**) from the requirements under the Specification Pack for sending and/or receiving of communications via the FRC Hub.

On 10 October 2012, the Authority approved Rule Change C03/12R on the basis that the proposed amendment will simplify the communications process for SCUs, which will remove a potential barrier to entry for SCUs. The Authority believes that the Scheme will continue to comply with the Act following the approval of this rule change.

Rule Change C03/12R will be effective from 16 October 2012.
