Electricity Code Consultative Committee Gas Marketing Code Consultative Committee

APPOINTMENT OF EXECUTIVE OFFICER

The Economic Regulation Authority today announced the appointment of Dr David Leith, A/Assistant Director Customer Protection, as Executive Officer to the Electricity Code Consultative Committee (**ECCC**) and Gas Marketing Code Consultative Committee (**GMCCC**).

ECCC

The *Electricity Industry Act 2004* requires the Authority to establish a committee to review the *Code of Conduct for the Supply of Electricity to Small Use Customers* (**Electricity Code**) and to provide advice when the Authority proposes to amend the Electricity Code. The Electricity Code regulates the conduct of electricity retailers, distributors and marketers in relation to the supply and marketing of electricity.

The ECCC consists of four consumer organisation representatives, four industry representatives, two government representatives and a non-voting chairperson and executive officer.

GMCCC

The *Energy Coordination Act 1994* requires the Authority to establish a committee to review the *Gas Marketing Code of Conduct* (**Gas Code**) and to provide advice when the Authority proposes to amend the Gas Code. The Gas Code regulates the conduct of the holders of trading licenses and marketers in relation to the marketing of gas.

The GMCCC consists of three consumer organisation representatives, three industry representatives, two government representatives and a non-voting chairperson and executive officer.
