Resourcing is also provided for management assurance audits of the wind farm sites, in addition to internal audit. Current activities under the ERMP include: - the introduction of a quarterly internal compliance sign-off process, to complement existing external compliance reporting; and - consideration of a system to automate the notification and monitoring of compliance obligations.
