Review of the Western Australian Electricity Market Metrology Procedure for Metering Installations

Further to the recent amendment of the *Electricity Industry Metering Code 2012 (Code)*, Western Power has undertaken a comprehensive review of the Western Australian Electricity Market Metrology Procedure for Metering Installations (**Metrology Procedure**) to align the document with the requirements of the updated Code.

The review of the Metrology Procedure resulted in a number of changes. In addition to the change to the document's title (now the Metrology Procedure for Metering Installations on the Western Power Network) and substantial amendments to its structure, other key changes include:

- Inclusion of additional requirements around accumulation meters, bidirectional electricity flows, meter type determination and reliability of metering installations
- Clarification of the calculation of trading intervals
- Clarification of the requirement to provide notice to users of changes to standing data
- Inclusion of pre-payment meter requirements
- Clarification of ownership, security and rights of access to data
- Inclusion of requirements as to annual meter reads, customer directions for data provision and charges for provision of data
- Inclusion of requirements for provision of information by a user

Pursuant to clause 6.20(2) of the Code, Western Power requests that the Authority initiate a review of the updated Metrology Procedure. Western Power undertakes to amend the Metrology Procedure in accordance with the Authority's recommendations, if any, prior to publishing the document.
