Review of Western Power's Metrology Procedure for Metering Installations on the Western Power Network

The Economic Regulation Authority (**Authority**) has received two submissions in response to its consultation on the review of Western Power's Metrology Procedure for Metering Installations on the Western Power Network.¹

The submissions, from Community Electricity and Synergy, are available on the Authority's <u>website</u>.

Next Steps

The Authority has asked Western Power to engage with the relevant code participants and other interested parties to resolve the issues raised in the submissions.

Western Power has been asked to submit a report detailing how the issues raised have been resolved and, if necessary, resubmit an updated Metrology Procedure to the Authority by **4:00 pm (WST) Friday, 30 January 2015**. Following this, the Authority will be in a position to review the proposed amendments and publish its draft findings for consultation.

Taking into account the above process, the Authority has decided to extend the time limit for publishing the draft findings in relation to the review until 16 March 2015.
