## Publication of the National Performance Report 2013-14 Urban Water Utilities

Western Australia is a signatory to the National Water Initiative Agreement (**NWIA**). Under the NWIA, signatory governments have agreed to independently and publicly report on pricing and service quality of water service providers every year. The Economic Regulation Authority, along with the Department of Water, represents Western Australia on the committee that oversees the production of the National Performance Report, Urban Water Utilities (**Urban Report**).

The Bureau of Meteorology (**Bureau**) has published the 2013-14 National Performance Report, Urban Water Utilities. The report is available on the Bureau's [website](#).

The Urban Report presents comparative performance data by water service providers across Australia for water supply and sewerage schemes that service more than 10,000 connected properties. In Western Australia this includes supply schemes operated by Bunbury Water Corporation (trading as Aqwest), Busselton Water Corporation (trading as Busselton Water), City of Kalgoorlie-Boulder and Water Corporation.

Areas covered in the Urban Report include: sources of water; water consumption; water recycling; supply reliability; water network losses; environmental performance; compliance with drinking water standards; and financial performance.
