Community notes from the ERA's issues paper that:

- i) the end-user intends to install an 885kVA non-exporting PPG;
- ii) Wagin substation is currently operating under a Technical Rules exemption because of its age and will be brought up to standard as part of the network development planning;
- iii) granting of the exemption will not of itself comprise safety or reliability of supply for other users;
- iv) the end-user has accepted the proposed solution and supports the application for exemption;
- v) Western Power considers that the proposed connection arrangement permits the end-user to obtain a covered service to the extent reasonably practicable in accordance with good electricity practice while efficiently minimising the cost of network augmentation.

On this basis, Community considers the exemption to be in the public interest and we support it.
