Amendments to the REMCo Retail Market Rules

DECISION

The Economic Regulation Authority (**ERA**) has approved amendments to the Retail Energy Market Company's (**REMCo**) Retail Market Scheme (**Scheme**), providing for the operation of the Western Australian Gas Retail Market.

Among other things, the Scheme comprises: the Retail Market Rules (**Rules**) and the Specification Pack (**Spec Pack**). The Spec Pack includes a series of documents that define how participants interact with market systems and other participants' systems.

On 30 October 2015, REMCo submitted Rule Change proposals C03/15RS, C04/15S and C05/15R to the ERA for approval.

Rule Change proposal C03/15R proposed to add a note to Retail Market Rule 79 to increase clarity on the Explicit Informed Consent requirements for when a customer moves in to a premises.

Rule Change proposal C04/15S proposed to amend a typographic error in the Spec Pack.

Rule Change proposal C05/15R proposed to update Appendix 1 of the Rules to recognize a new gate point from the interconnection of Parmelia Pipeline to Metro-South Sub-network.

The ERA has approved the amendments to the Retail Market Scheme, which will take effect on 1 January 2016
