



1. Introduction

The IMO is required by clause 2.13.26 of the Market Rules to release a report at least every six months setting out a summary for the preceding six months of:

- Proceedings that have been brought before the Electricity Review Board;
- Findings of the Electricity Review Board on matters referred to them;
- Orders made by the Electricity Review Board; and
- Civil penalties imposed by the IMO under clause 2.13.16(a) of the Market Rules, where the Electricity Review Board has not set these aside.

This report provides a summary of those matters for the six-month period from 21 March 2010 to 20 September 2010.
