Roy Hill Infrastructure Railway Proposed Regulatory Instruments

INVITATION FOR PUBLIC SUBMISSIONS

The Economic Regulation Authority (ERA) is seeking public comment on segregation arrangements and Part 5 Instruments proposed by Roy Hill Infrastructure for its railway in the Pilbara.

Section 28 of the *Railways (Access) Act 1998* requires that a railway owner must make arrangements to segregate its access-related functions from its other functions, and ensure appropriate controls and procedures are in place.

Section 29 of the Act requires that before a railway owner puts in place or varies any of its segregation arrangements, it must obtain the ERA's approval.

The requirements for a railway owner to put in place Train Management Guidelines, Train Path Policy, Costing Principles and Over-payment Rules are described in Part 5 of the *Railways* (Access) Code 2000.
