An individual Facility's operations in respect of MW inflows and outflows into and out of the SWIS are measured at its connection point to the network. Therefore, an individual Facility is defined by its connection point to network (usually its meter point(s)) and is required to submit an individual resource plan. Therefore, an aggregated facility must comprise more than one meter point. That is, an individual Facility with one meter point and multiple generating units cannot become an aggregated facility without additional meter points.

Consistent with the understanding above, Spinning Reserve must, of necessity, be allocated on a Facility by Facility basis rather than on an aggregated facility basis.
