Community Electricity supports the Rule Change Proposal on the grounds that it corrects a manifest error.

In particular we support the principles that:

- a) A Facility subject to a Dispatch Instruction should be granted a tolerance within which it is to comply with the instruction so as to accommodate reasonable operational variations;
- b) A Facility that is compliant with a Dispatch Instruction should only be eligible for constrained-operation payments when it is dispatched out-or-merit.

Community also supports application of the Fast Track procedure to correct the manifest error.

Community considers that the Rule Change improves the integrity of the Market Rules by correcting a manifest error.
