## Approval of amendments to Horizon Power's standard form contract

The Economic Regulation Authority (ERA) has approved amendments to Horizon Power's standard form contract for the supply of electricity to small use customers.

In September 2016, Horizon Power submitted an amended standard form contract for the ERA's approval. The ERA provided feedback to Horizon Power on the proposed amendments, and in response to this feedback Horizon Power submitted a revised contract in December 2016.

The ERA released the amended standard form contract for public consultation on 3 February 2017. No submissions were received.

Under the *Electricity Industry Act 2004* (Act), the ERA must not approve a standard form contract if it considers the contract does not meet the relevant regulations, the Act, any other written law, or any term, condition or provision of the electricity licence.

The ERA has considered Horizon Power's amended standard form contract and is satisfied that the contract meets the requirements of the Act.
