Roy Hill Infrastructure proposed Segregation Arrangements

DRAFT DECISION

The Economic Regulation Authority (ERA) has published its <u>Draft Decision</u> on segregation arrangements submitted by Roy Hill Infrastructure (RHI) for approval in June 2016 and invites interested parties to make submissions.

The ERA's Draft Decision is to approve RHI's proposed segregation arrangements subject to amendments, which include:

- Removal of multiple references to the recovery of costs incurred by the parent company and costs associated with implementing the segregation arrangements, which are not appropriate in the segregation arrangements document
- Removal of references to access-related costs as being an "additional burden" on RHI;
 these costs are part of the normal business of RHI
- Removal of references to the subsequent development of "controls and procedures" and the inclusion of controls and procedures documentation as a part of the segregation arrangements
- Inclusion of more comprehensive protections of confidential information

Interested parties are invited to make submissions on the draft decision by **4.00 pm** (WST) on 23 February 2017.

Submissions should be made via the portal on the ERA website.

The ERA previously published RHI's proposed segregation arrangements and commenced public consultation on 25 October 2016. One submission was received, from The Pilbara Infrastructure.
