In accordance with clause 2.5.10 of the Market Rules, the Independent Market Operator (IMO) has extended the timeframe for the publication for the Draft Rule Change Report for the Rule Change Proposal titled Outage Planning Phase 2 – Outage Process Refinements (RC_2013_15) until **Friday 30 May 2014**.

Dates for subsequent steps of the rule change process have been adjusted accordingly.

Reasons for the Extension

The IMO has extended the period for the preparation of the Draft Rule Change Report to:

- allow the IMO time to complete its assessment of the submissions received in the first submission period; and
- allow System Management time to develop the necessary changes to the Power System Operation Procedure (PSOP): Facility Outages and to ensure the consistency of the proposed Amending Rules in the Draft Rule Change Report and the proposed amended PSOP.


Proposed Work Programme
