## **Roy Hill Infrastructure - proposed Segregation Arrangements**

## FINAL DECISION

The Economic Regulation Authority (ERA) has published its <u>Final Decision</u> on segregation arrangements submitted by Roy Hill Infrastructure (RHI) for approval in June 2016.

The ERA's Final Decision is to approve RHI's proposed segregation arrangements subject to amendments, which include:

- Removal of references to the recovery of costs incurred by the parent company and costs associated with implementing the segregation arrangements, as segregation arrangements do not deal with the determination or recovery of costs
- Removal of references to access-related costs as being an "additional burden" on RHI, as these costs are part of the normal business of RHI
- Removal of references to the subsequent development of "controls and procedures". Instead, controls and procedures documentation is to be included as a part of the segregation arrangements
- Inclusion of more comprehensive protections of confidential information

The ERA published a draft decision on 9 February 2017 and sought comment on both RHI's proposed Segregation Arrangements and the ERA's draft decision. RHI provided a submission in response to the draft decision and this submission is published on the ERA's website.

RHI is now required to provide its Segregation Arrangements incorporating the required amendments to the ERA for publication by 31 May 2017.
