1. Please provide your views on the proposal, including any objections or suggested revisions

LGP supports the Rule Change proposal on the grounds that an efficient and effective market should permit commissioning generators reasonable operational flexibility and System Management should not be required to real-time monitor their activities when they are not impacting system security. We perceive the Rule Change to properly preserve System Management's obligations and powers to manage the system whilst facilitating the needed flexibility.

LGP supports the Fast Tracking of this Rule Change to accommodate the needs of a new entrant generator.

LGP supports System Management's contention that the proposal supports market objective (a) (to promote the economically efficient, safe and reliable production and supply of Electricity) by allowing a new Facility to complete commissioning without having to comply with potentially burdensome requirements that are both an impediment for the generator and an unnecessary distraction for System Management.
