RULE CHANGE EXTENSION NOTICE

Constrained On/Off Compensation removal where a Facility is non-compliant with Dispatch Instructions (RC_2012_25)

This notice of extension is given under clause 2.5.12 of the Market Rules.

Reasons for the Extension

In accordance with clause 2.5.10 of the Market Rules, the IMO has extended the timeframe for publishing the Final Rule Change Report for the Rule Change Proposal titled Constrained On/Off Compensation removal where a Facility is non-compliant with Dispatch Instructions (RC_2012_25) by two Business Days.

The publication date for the Final Rule Change Report has been extended until Thursday, 21 February 2013. The timeframe has been extended to allow the IMO sufficient time to appropriately address the proposed amendment of a Protected Provision (clause 9.16.3) in the Final Rule Change Report. The extension is within the time limits prescribed in clause 2.5.11 of the Market Rules for a Rule Change Proposal subject to the Fast Track Rule Change Process.


Proposed Work Programme
