Approval of minor amendments to the AGL Sales Pty Ltd gas standard form contract

The Economic Regulation Authority (**ERA**) has approved minor amendments to the AGL Sales Pty Ltd standard form contract for the supply of gas to small use customers¹.

In May 2017, the ERA approved the initial AGL standard form contract when it granted AGL's gas trading licence <u>GTL14</u>.

On 22 June 2017, AGL requested the following amendments to its contract:

- Page 2 updating the term "standard retail contract" to "standard form contract".
- Page 3, clause 4.3 removing the wording "install a meter and" as this is not applicable to existing connections.
- Page 20 updating the AGL website address and email contact address.

Due to the minor nature of these amendments, the ERA did not release the amended standard form contract for public consultation.²

Under the *Energy Coordination Act 1994*, the ERA must not approve a standard form contract if it considers the contract does not meet the relevant regulations, the Act, any other written law, or any term, condition or provision of the gas licence. The ERA is satisfied that the amended standard form contract meets these requirements.
