Western Power invites submissions on Perth CBD project

Western Power has invited submissions on its proposal for supply reinforcement for the Perth CBD.

The proposed works will involve the installation of a new 132 kV transmission cable between the Hay Street and Milligan Street substations.

Under the *Electricity Networks Access Code 2004* (Access Code) Western Power is required to advise the ERA about major augmentations to its covered network. It must also consult with the public and interested parties.

Details about the proposed changes can be found in the Western Power options paper.

The public is invited to make submissions to Western Power regarding alternative options or opinions on the proposed augmentation. As part of this process, Western Power is hosting a public forum on Tuesday, 1 August 2017, at the Western Power Head Office.

Please direct all enquiries regarding the proposal to Western Power.

Following the consultation process, Western Power must consider the views and alternative options in the submissions it receives. Western Power will then submit a major augmentation proposal to the ERA for regulatory consideration.
