South West Cogeneration surrenders its electricity generation licence

The Economic Regulation Authority (**ERA**) advises that Electricity Generation and Retail Corporation & Origin Energy SWC Limited (South West Cogeneration Joint Venture, **SWCJV**) has surrendered electricity generation licence EGL9.

The SWCJV generation plant supplied steam and electricity to South32 Worsley Alumina Pty Ltd's refinery north west of Collie. The excess energy from the plant was sold to Synergy under a power purchase agreement. The plant ceased operating when SWCJV's energy supply contracts expired on 27 March 2016.

Clause 8.4 of EGL9 states that the surrender of the licence will only take effect when the licensee has handed back its licence to the ERA and the ERA has published a notice of the surrender in the Western Australian Government Gazette.

SWCJV handed back its licence on 26 July 2017.

The ERA will publish a notice in the Gazette as soon as practicable.
