## **Consultation on Amanda Energy Pty Ltd standard form contract**

The Economic Regulation Authority (**ERA**) invites comments on Amanda Energy Pty Ltd's (**Amanda Energy**) proposed standard form contract for the supply of gas to small use business customers.<sup>1</sup>

On 30 June 2017, Amanda Energy applied for a trading licence to sell gas to business customers in the coastal supply area of Western Australia stretching from Geraldton to Augusta, including the Perth metropolitan area. A summary of the <u>licence application</u> is on the ERA website.

Licence applicants must submit a draft standard form contract, under which they will supply customers, with their application.

Under the *Energy Coordination Act 1994* (**Act**), the ERA must not approve a standard form contract if it considers the contract does not meet the requirements of the Act, the relevant regulations, any other written law, or any term, condition or provision of the gas trading licence.

Interested parties are invited to make submissions on the proposed <u>standard form contract</u> by **21 September 2017**.
