Final findings on Horizon Power's amended mandatory link criteria

The Economic Regulation Authority (ERA) has completed its review of Horizon Power's amended mandatory link criteria for metering installations connected to its network.

The ERA finds the amended criteria meet the approval requirements of the Electricity Industry (Metering) Code 2012.

BACKGROUND

Mandatory link criteria specify any communication links required as part of a metering installation. A communications link enables a meter to be read from a remote location.

The review began in September 2017 and interested parties were given the opportunity to comment on the proposed changes. No comments were received.

The draft findings found the amended criteria met the approval requirements of the code, subject to Horizon Power retaining two clauses within the amended criteria. The draft findings were published on 14 November 2017.

Interested parties were given the opportunity to make submissions on the draft findings by 12 December 2017. No submissions were received.

The final findings are unchanged from those outlined in the draft findings.

The code requires Horizon Power to amend its mandatory link criteria in accordance with the ERA's findings (where required) and publish the amended criteria on its website.

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
