Electricity Licence Review 2018 - Consultation on Discussion Paper

The Economic Regulation Authority (ERA) invites comment on its [Discussion Paper](#) for the Electricity Licence Review 2018.

In accordance with the *Electricity Industry Act 2004*, the ERA administers Western Australia's licensing scheme for electricity supply services. Electricity licence types are generation, transmission, distribution, retail and integrated regional.¹

The objectives of the Electricity Licence Review 2018 are to ensure that electricity licences:

- are consistent with applicable legislation;²
- minimise licensees' regulatory burden and compliance costs;
- have clear and consistent terms and conditions across the licence types; and
- are consistent with gas and water licences where possible.

¹ Integrated regional licences authorise a person to carry out one or more of generation, transmission, distribution or retail services for the purpose of supplying electricity to customers outside the South West Interconnected System.

² Applicable legislation includes the *Electricity Industry Act 2004* and relevant codes and regulations.
