Consultation on CleanTech Energy Pty Ltd's application to amend its electricity retail licence

Electricity retail licence no. 24

The Economic Regulation Authority (**ERA**) is seeking public comment on an application by CleanTech Energy Pty Ltd (**CleanTech**) to supply electricity to small use business customers that consume between 50MWh and 160MWh of electricity per year on the South West Interconnected System.

This will require an amendment to CleanTech's electricity retail licence ERL24.

A summary of the <u>licence amendment application</u> and a copy of CleanTech's existing licence <u>ERL24</u> are available on the ERA website.

The grant of the licence amendment is subject to the ERA being satisfied that it would not be contrary to the public interest to do so and that the applicant:

- has, and is likely to retain; or
- will acquire within a reasonable time after the grant, and is then likely to retain,

the financial and technical resources to undertake the activities authorised by the licence.

The ERA invites interested parties to make public submissions on the licence application.

Submissions close 4:00 pm (WST) on 27 February 2018.
