## Public Transport Authority Proposed Revised Segregation Arrangements

### INVITATION FOR PUBLIC SUBMISSIONS

The Economic Regulation Authority (ERA) is seeking public comment on revisions proposed by the Public Transport Authority to its Segregation Arrangements.

The *Railways (Access) Act 1998* requires that a railway owner must make arrangements to segregate its access-related functions from its other functions, and must have appropriate controls and procedures to ensure that the measures in place operate effectively and are complied with. Access-related functions are the functions involved in arranging the provision of access to railway infrastructure under the Code.

The Act requires that before a railway owner puts in place or varies any arrangement it must obtain the ERA's approval.

The main proposed amendments to the Public Transport Authority's Segregation Arrangements are:

- consolidation of schedules attached to the arrangements into the main body of the document
- additions to the list of examples of confidential information at section 7.3.3.3
- an update to the description of the Public Transport Authority network at section 3.3
- an update to the list of responsible position titles at section 7.3.11
- replacement of the Compliance and Review sections at 7.1 and 7.2
