

Proposed amendments to the Code of Conduct for the Supply of Electricity to Small Use Customers

INVITATION FOR PUBLIC SUBMISSIONS

The Electricity Code Consultative Committee (ECCC) seeks public comment on the amendments proposed by the Economic Regulation Authority (ERA) to the *Code of Conduct* for the Supply of Electricity to Small Use Customers (Code).

In December 2017, the ECCC submitted to the ERA its <u>Final Review Report</u> on the 2017 statutory review of the Code. The Final Review Report included 24 recommendations to amend the Code, which were all accepted by the ERA.

On 23 February 2018, the ERA has published its <u>Draft Decision</u> on the proposed amendments to the Code.

The *Electricity Industry Act 2004* (**Act**) requires the ERA to consult with the ECCC prior to amending the Code. The Act also requires that the committee give any interested person an opportunity to comment before providing its advice to the ERA. The ECCC therefore invites written submissions on the ERA's proposed amendments to the Code, as set out in its Draft Decision.

Submissions, addressed to Mr Paul Kelly, Chairman ECCC are due by **4:00 pm (WST)** Monday, 26 March 2018. Late submissions will not be considered.
