Consultation on CleanTech Energy Pty Ltd's standard form contract

The Economic Regulation Authority (**ERA**) invites comments on CleanTech Energy Pty Ltd's (**CleanTech Energy**) proposed standard form contract for the supply of electricity to small use business customers that consume between 50MWh and 160MWh of electricity per year on the South West Interconnected System.

On 15 January 2018, CleanTech Energy applied for an amendment to its electricity retail licence ERL24. A summary of the [licence amendment application](#) is on the ERA website.

Electricity retail licence amendment applicants must submit a proposed standard form contract, under which they will supply customers, with their application.

Under the *Electricity Industry Act 2004 (Act)*, the ERA must not approve a standard form contract if it considers the contract does not meet the requirements of the Act, the relevant regulations, any other written law, or any term, condition or provision of the electricity retail licence.
