Pty Limited (<b>EPC</b>) must demonstrate to the ERA that the Kambalda to Esperance Gas Pipeline (<b>KEGP</b>) does not provide third party access.</p> <p>We submit the following information to demonstrate this:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The KEGP was built and commissioned in early 2003 to transport high-pressure natural gas from Kambalda to Esperance to supply the Esperance Power Station and the Esperance gas distribution system.</li> <li>2. The KEGP is owned by Esperance Pipeline Co. Pty Limited (<b>EPC</b>).</li> <li>3. The Esperance Power Station and the Esperance gas distribution system are owned by Esperance Power Station Pty Ltd (<b>EPS</b>).</li> <li>4. Please refer to the attached corporate structure diagram showing the relationship between these companies (Attachment 3).</li> <li>5. The KEGP is <u>not</u> a "third party access pipeline" because:             <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. EPC only provides services on the KEGP to EPS, and capacity on the KEGP is fully contracted.</li> <li>b. EPC and EPS are related bodies corporate.</li> <li>c. EPC has not actively sought to market or provide services on the KEGP to any third parties to date.</li> </ol> </li> <li>6. In addition, and if necessary for the purposes of a Category 2 Exemption, we submit that the KEGP is a "single shipper pipeline" because EPC only provides services on the KEGP to EPS.</li> <li>7.
