## Draft Rate of Return Guidelines (2018) for Gas Transmission and Distribution Networks

## STAKEHOLDER FORUM

The Economic Regulation Authority (ERA) is currently undertaking a review of the Gas Rate of Return Guidelines. The guidelines detail the method the ERA uses to estimate the allowed rate of return for gas transmission and distribution service providers.

On 29 June 2018 the ERA released its Draft Guidelines for public comment.

To enable early feedback from all stakeholders ahead of formal submissions, the ERA is holding a forum for interested parties on **Monday, 3 September 2018**.

At this forum, the ERA will provide an overview of its Draft Rate of Return Guidelines and seek feedback from those who attend.
