Landfill Gas & Power Pty Ltd

2018 Performance Audit

The Economic Regulation Authority has published the 2018 performance audit <u>report</u> for Landfill Gas & Power Pty Ltd's (LGP) electricity retail licence ERL11.

ERL11 authorises LGP to sell electricity to large-use customers¹ connected to the South West Interconnected System.

ERA's response to the audit

The ERA considers LGP has achieved a high level of compliance with its licence.

The ERA has decided to retain the audit period of 48 months for the next audit. The next audit will cover 1 July 2018 to 30 June 2022, with the report due by 30 September 2022.

Background to the ERA's decision

Audit ratings

The auditor determined that there were 74 licence obligations applicable to LGP's licence:

- 34 were rated A1 (adequate controls, compliant).
- Two were rated B1 (generally adequate controls, compliant).
- Two were rated B/NR (generally adequate controls, not rated for compliance due to lack of relevant activity).
- 36 were rated NP/NR (not performed, not rated for compliance due to lack of relevant activity).

Audit recommendations

The auditor made two recommendations that address control improvement opportunities.

A large-use customer is a customer who consumes more than 160 MWh of electricity per year.

Because no non-compliances were identified during the audit, LGP did not provide a post-audit implementation plan.²

ERA's assessment of the audit findings

The ERA considers LGP is operating effectively and has exhibited a high level of compliance with its licence.

Further information

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As per section 11.8 of the <u>2014 Audit and Review Guidelines: Electricity and Gas Licences</u>, it is only mandatory to provide a post-audit implementation plan if licence obligations have been rated C, D, 2, 3 or 4.
