Inquiry into reform of business licensing in Western Australia

Release of draft report

The Economic Regulation Authority has released a draft report on its inquiry into options to reform state government business licensing in Western Australia.

During the inquiry, the ERA consulted with government agencies, industry groups, unions, the ERA Consumer Consultative Committee and the public. In February 2018, interested parties had the opportunity to provide feedback on the ERA's consultation papers. The ERA received 20 submissions and 25 responses to an online questionnaire, which are published on the ERA's website.

The information contributed by stakeholders has greatly enhanced the ERA's understanding of the issues affecting business licensing in Western Australia. The ERA appreciates the time and effort taken by all those who took part.

Invitation for submissions

The ERA invites feedback on the draft report. The draft report makes a number of recommendations and requests further information about problems with state government business licensing. Your input will assist the ERA to prepare its final report and recommendations, to be provided to the Treasurer on 22 February 2019.
