## **Non-scheme Gas Pipeline Exemption Revocation**

### **Final decision on revocation application for the Kambalda to Esperance Gas Pipeline**

The Economic Regulation Authority has dismissed an application to revoke the Kambalda to Esperance Gas Pipeline (KEGP) exemptions from the arbitration and information disclosure requirements under Part 23 of the National Gas Rules.

The application was received on 8 June 2018. Rule 588(2) allows for any person to apply to the ERA to revoke an approved exemption. Category 1 exempts a non-scheme pipeline from the access and arbitration requirements of the Rules. Category 2 exempts the non-scheme pipeline from information disclosure requirements.

The ERA provided its draft decision to both the applicant and the owner of the KEGP on 25 September 2018. As required under Rule 590 (decision to vary or revoke an exemption), the ERA invited KEGP's owner to make a submission in response to its draft decision. The draft decision advised of the ERA's intention to revoke the Category 1 exemption on the KEGP. On 22 October 2018, KEGP's owner provided a submission to the ERA, disagreeing with the ERA's draft decision.

Based on further analysis of this submission and other information provided, the ERA has dismissed the application to revoke the Category 1 and Category 2 exemptions in its final decision. A copy of the final decision has been provided to the applicant and the KEGP owner.
