Surrender of electricity generation licence EGL16

The Economic Regulation Authority advises that Eneabba Energy Pty Ltd has surrendered electricity generation licence EGL16. Eneabba Energy notified the ERA of the surrender on 2 November 2018.

The ERA granted electricity generation licence EGL16 to Eneabba Energy on 12 March 2007 for the construction and operation of the gas fired Centauri 1 power station, located near Dongara in the Mid-West. The licence was due to expire on 11 March 2037.

Eneabba Energy planned to supply energy to the Mid-West region and the metropolitan area through the South West Interconnected System. After it was granted the licence, Eneabba Energy was unable to obtain funding for the project and the Centauri 1 power station was never built.

The surrender of the licence will take effect when the ERA publishes a notice of the surrender in the Western Australian Government Gazette. The ERA will do so as soon as practicable.
