Invitation for public submissions - Application to amend water services licence WL38

The Economic Regulation Authority is seeking public comment on an application by Gascoyne Water Co-operative Limited to amend the <u>operating area</u> of <u>water services licence WL38</u>.

Gascoyne Water is a co-operative that provides irrigation water services to local growers and non-potable water to properties in the Carnarvon area.

Gascoyne Water is seeking to expand its operating area to include:

- The Northern Gascoyne River borefield.
- Proposed land releases that are part of the Gascoyne Food Bowl Initiative's Water for Food program in the Carnarvon area.
- The Carnarvon Waste Disposal Facility at Brown's Range.
- A proposed bore.
- Three sand spears¹ that were installed under the Water for Food program.

¹ A sand spear is a shallow well bore that pumps water from the water table underground to the surface.
