Wholesale Electricity Market and Gas Services Information Rules

Compliance Report

The Economic Regulation Authority has published its six-monthly compliance report under the Wholesale Electricity Market Rules and the Gas Services Information Rules.

The report contains an update on compliance activities for the period 1 July 2018 to 31 December 2018. This includes alleged breaches reported to the ERA, outcomes of breach investigations and results of the ERA's quarterly process for investigating participant compliance with dispatch instructions.

This period, the ERA Secretariat recorded 127 new alleged breach matters for investigation. This number was lower than the 146 matters registered in the previous six months.

The Secretariat noticed an improvement in Dispatch Instruction compliance through its quarterly investigation process, but has include some discussion in this report about two material non-compliance matters that it identified. Both matters concerned non-compliant after gate closure Balancing Submissions, which resulted in the ERA issuing two formal warnings.

The ERA's report provides information to assist participants to comply with the rules.

The rules also require the ERA to report on matters brought before the Electricity Review Board. There were no matters during the reporting period.
