BEI WWF Pty Ltd as trustee for the WWF Trust Consultation on electricity generation licence application

The Economic Regulation Authority is seeking public comment on an application by BEI WWF Pty Ltd as trustee for the WWF Trust to construct and operate an 180MW wind farm at Warradarge in the mid-west of Western Australia. The proposed Warradarge Wind Farm will be located approximately 260km north of Perth in the Shire of Coorow.

The proposed licence services will include electricity generation only.

The grant of the licence amendment is subject to the ERA being satisfied that it would not be contrary to the public interest to do so and that the applicant:

- has, and is likely to retain; or
- will acquire within a reasonable time after the grant, and is then likely to retain,

the financial and technical resources to undertake the activities authorised by the licence.
