#### 10 ENERGY OMBUDSMAN REPORT

Mr Field introduced Ms Mary White, the Deputy Energy Ombudsman. Mr Field and Ms White provided an overview of the quarterly report (which included the statistics report as an attachment). The Ombudsman highlighted the high rate of complaints and disconnections for electricity customers compared to the same time last year. Ms White stated that this could be a spike as a result of Synergy's current focus on debt recovery and issuing late bills.

Mr Reid advised that the application of financial hardship policies by retailers will be assessed by the ERA's monitoring team in upcoming audits of retail licensees who supply small use customers.

Mr Field requested feedback on the report, via the ERACCC meetings or otherwise.

Ms Cattalini requested permission for additional WACOSS staff to attend ERACCC meetings as observers as she feels some of the presentations would be particularly useful to them. Mr
