## Perth Energy Pty Ltd

Amendment to electricity retail licence ERL10

The Economic Regulation Authority has approved an amendment to Perth Energy Pty Ltd's electricity retail licence, ERL10, to insert licence clauses that were inadvertently removed during the 2018 Electricity Licence Review.

The missing clauses are standard licence clauses, which apply to all retail licensees that supply electricity to small use customers.<sup>1</sup><sup>2</sup>

Consistent with the ERA's <u>Consultation Guidelines</u>, the ERA did not undertake public consultation on this amendment, because it is minor and administrative.

The amended licence ERL10, version 7 is available on the ERA website.
