Application to revoke Technical Rule temporary exemption granted to Western Power for Meadow Springs zone substation

RELEASE OF FINAL DECISION

The Economic Regulation Authority has published its <u>final decision</u> to not approve Mr Stephen Davidson's application to revoke Western Power's exemption from compliance with clause 2.5.4(b) of the Technical Rules' capacity requirements at the Meadow Springs zone substation.

The ERA initially granted Western Power an exemption to the rule, which sets the maximum amount of power that can be transferred through a substation, in July 2015. Western Power requested the exemption to enable it to defer capital expenditure in the Mandurah load area.

In December 2016, the ERA received an application to revoke this exemption. The ERA started to review this application, but before it could issue a decision the applicant applied to the Electricity Review Board for a review. The ERA's process was placed on hold until this process was completed in October 2018.
