Proposed revised access arrangement for the Mid-West and South-West Gas Distribution Systems

Consultation – Demand forecasts

The Economic Regulation Authority has published a <u>report</u> assessing ATCO Gas Australia's demand forecasts for the proposed revised access arrangement for the Mid-West and South-West Gas Distribution Systems.

The ERA commissioned Woollahra Partners to review the gas demand forecasts contained in ATCO's response to the ERA draft decision. Woollahra Partners provided its final report on 5 September 2019.

The ERA will consider the report as it prepares the Final Decision, including the effect of gas retail discounting on price elasticity.

The Mid-West and South-West Gas Distribution Systems services Geraldton, Bunbury, Busselton, Harvey, Pinjarra, Brunswick Junction, Capel, Mandurah and the Perth greater metropolitan area. These combined networks supply approximately 750,000 residential, commercial and industrial customers through more than 14,000 kilometres of pipeline.
