The Pilbara Infrastructure proposed revised Segregation Arrangements

Approval of amended arrangements

The ERA has approved amended Segregation Arrangements proposed by The Pilbara Infrastructure in July 2019.

The *Railways (Access) Act 1998* requires that a railway owner must make arrangements to segregate its access-related functions from its other functions and have appropriate controls and procedures to ensure that the arrangements operate effectively and are complied with.

The amendments include:

- The addition of text to clarify the distinction between access-related functions and other functions.
- Making some terms consistent with the use of those terms in the *Railways (Access)* Code 2000.
- Including detail contained in attachments into the body of the document.

The ERA invited public comment on the proposed amended Segregation Arrangements on 25 July 2019. We received one submission in support of the amendments from Roy Hill Infrastructure.
