TMC Witchcliffe Pty Ltd

Decision to grant water services licence and approve financial hardship policy

The Economic Regulation Authority has granted water services licence 50 (WL50) to TMC Witchcliffe Pty Ltd and has approved TMC's financial hardship policy.

TMC will supply non-potable water and sewerage services to the Witchcliffe Ecovillage, south of Margaret River. TMC will design, construct and operate a sewerage scheme to provide sewerage services to approximately 414 residential and commercial lots. The collected sewage will be treated by an on-site wastewater treatment plant with recycled wastewater used to irrigate a nine-hectare avocado plantation within the development.
