

## Rule Change Extension Notice: Implementation of 30-Minute Balancing Gate Closure (RC\_2017\_02)

This notice of extension is given under clause 2.5.12 of the Market Rules.

In accordance with clause 2.5.10 of the Market Rules, the Rule Change Panel has further extended the timeframe for the publication of the Draft Rule Change Report for the Rule Change Proposal titled “Implementation of 30-Minute Balancing Gate Closure” (RC\_2017\_02) until **5:00 PM on Thursday 30 April 2020**.

Dates for subsequent steps of the rule change process have been adjusted accordingly.

### Reason for the Extension

To progress this Rule Change Proposal, the Rule Change Panel has consulted with:

- AEMO via numerous one-one-one sessions regarding the impact that a 30-minute, 60-minute or 90-minute Balancing Gate Closure would have on its systems and the dispatch process; and
- the Market Advisory Committee (**MAC**) at two workshops in late 2019.

Following this consultation, the Rule Change Panel has identified several material and complex issues that require further assessment before a draft decision can be made.

The Rule Change Panel has therefore extended the timeframe for publication of the Draft Rule Change Report until 30 April 2020 to allow the Rule Change Panel sufficient time to undertake the necessary investigation and analysis.
